The Dixfield Fire Company is committed to finding ways to improve our services. With the safety of our community in mind, the Dixfield Fire Company will offer an Emergency Registration process that will allow us to provide better service to you, our customer. This new service is offered at no cost to you, and it will provide us with contact information in the event we are called to your property for a fire, or fire-related emergency, at night when no one is there to let us in. It will provide us with a way to contact the appropriate person if there is a fire-related emergency involving your property that we think you should be made aware of.

Please register your business and information so we can notify you immediately if we need to gain access to your property. This may just save you money in the long run (forced-entry damage to doors & windows are expensive to replace). As additional option to emergency access to your property, I would like to introduce you to the KNOX-BOX® Rapid Entry System. The KNOX-BOX® is a one-key emergency access system to allow the fire department to gain entry to a location without needless forced entry damage. While the above registration is a good first step, there may be a time when fire department personnel need immediate access to respond to a fire-related emergency. With the KNOX-BOX® system, the fire department securely maintains a single key to access the KNOX-BOX® at your location, which in turn contains the key to your building.
